Did you ever try to get 10-12 kids in a room the size of a bathroom? Well, that's what it feels like here at our current facility. We cannot move about without rubbing shoulders with someone, somewhere. We're always saying "excuse me" as we move about.

This crowded situation tells me we need to move to a larger facility. In order to move to something bigger our monthly budget will also increase. Since our current budget is 2/3s funded by various outside gifts, donations and grants, we need a minimum of six months budget up-front to make such a move.

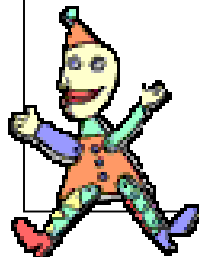

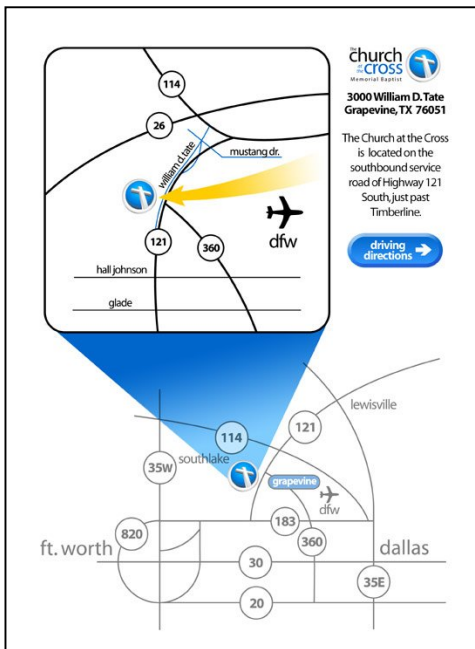

**COMING FROM:**

**Hurst, Eules, Bedford area**

From Highway 183, take Highway 121 North and exit William D. Tate. After exiting, make a U-turn at the traffic light. This will put you on William D. Tate heading South. William D. Tate becomes the service road for Highway 121 South. Stay on William D. Tate - do not get on Highway 121. The church is at 3000 William D. Tate Avenue, just past Timberline.

**Lewisville, Flower Mound, Coppell area**

Take Highway 121 South to Highway 114 West and exit William D. Tate from Highway 114. Turn left at the traffic light to cross over the bridge. This will put you on William D. Tate heading South. William D. Tate becomes the service road for Highway 121 South. Stay on William D. Tate - do not get on Highway 121. The church is at 3000 William D. Tate Avenue, just past Timberline.

**Irving, Dallas area**

Take Highway 114 West and exit William D. Tate. Turn left at the traffic light to cross over the bridge. This will put you on William D. Tate heading South. William D. Tate becomes the service road for Highway 121 South. Stay on William D. Tate - do not get on Highway 121. The church is at 3000 William D. Tate Avenue, just past Timberline.

**Colleyville, North Richland Hills area**

Take Highway 26 North, turn right on Mustang Drive, and then right on Timberline Drive (first red light). Take Timberline until it dead ends into William D. Tate Avenue, the service road for Highway 121 South. Turn right on William D. Tate heading South. The church is at 3000 William D. Tate Avenue, just past Timberline.

**Southlake, Trophy Club, Keller area**

Take Highway 114 East or FM 1709 to Highway 114 East. From Highway 114 East, exit William D. Tate. At the traffic light, turn right onto William D. Tate, which becomes the service road for Highway 121 South. Stay on William D. Tate - do not get on Highway 121. The church is at 3000 William D. Tate Avenue, just past Timberline.
