At The Clubhouse he loves to play on the Nintendo. He also likes table games.

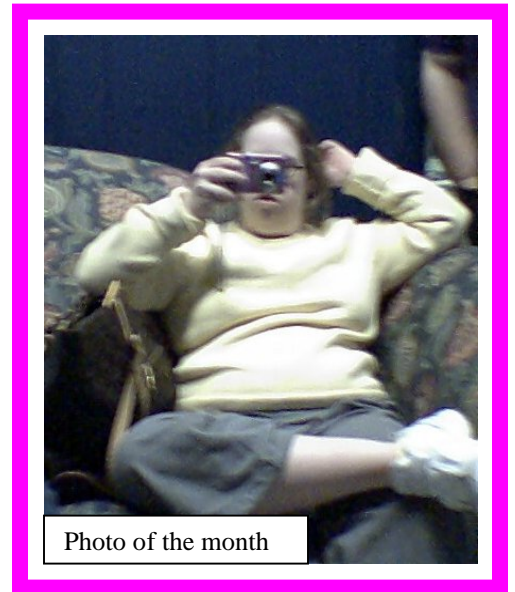
